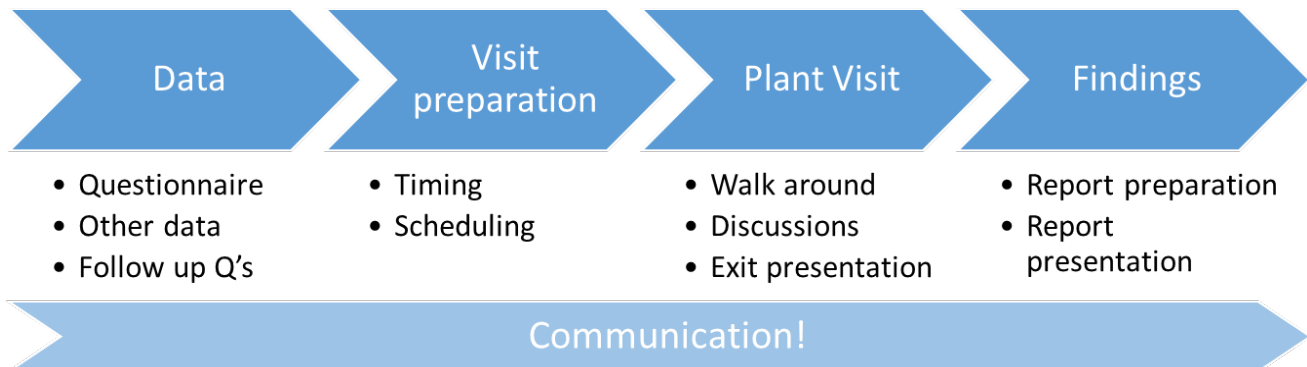

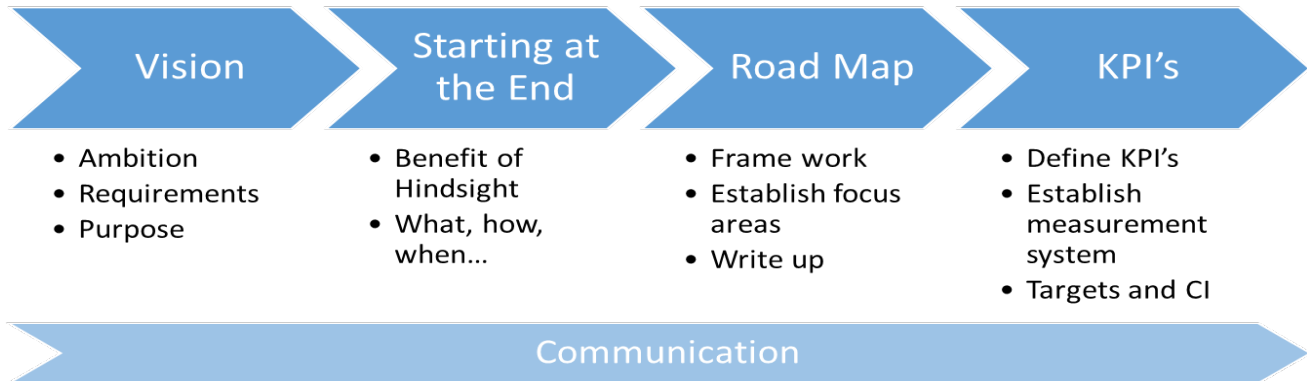

Safety Check Up



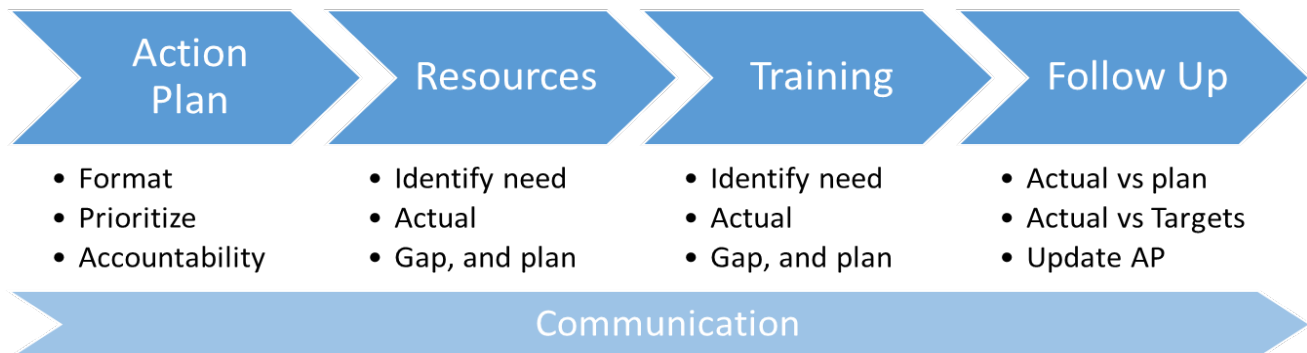
The Safety Check-up provides the initial understanding of both the current situation and the potential improvement areas. The process begins with Data collection through a questionnaire, proceeds to an on-site plant visit including meetings with key staff and ends with a findings report highlighting potential improvements.

Safety Strategy



Following the Safety Check-up, a Safety Strategy will be developed. In this process the findings discovered during the Check-up are compared to the overall Vision of the company and taking into account past successes and failures, a Road Map to World Class Safety is developed. KPIs are also defined which will best measure the steps to success following the Road Map.
